Dear applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the MathOR Programme for the 2022 Academic Year. Please complete this application form in accordance with the instructions. Kindly ensure that all supporting documents are included, so that your application can be taken into consideration.

Terms of acceptance into the programme

- The MathOR Programme is an extra class math programme for potentially strong academic learners from financially disadvantaged backgrounds. To be eligible to enroll for the programme, the applicant must demonstrate an interest and high potential to successfully complete a mathematics or science based university degree, does not have the financial resources to pay for professional tutoring, and have a minimum average achievement of 70% in maths.
- Attendance to all tutoring classes is required. In the case of no attendance, notice should be given as to the reason of your absence. A maximum of 5 classes may be missed during an academic year. In the case of absence from more than 5 classes, the learner may be expelled from the MathOR Programme in the case of no adequate reasons provided.
- Upon successful and satisfactory performance in mathematics at the end of each academic year (above 70% achievement), learners will automatically be accepted in the MathOR Programme for the following academic year.
- Upon successful completion of Grade 12, learners enrolled in the programme will be eligible to apply for a bursary to study towards a BCom/BSc (Mathematical Sciences) degree with Operations Research as focus area, or alternatively a BCom (Management Sciences) degree with Business Analytics as focus area, and Logistics and Transport Economics taken as electives.
- You are advised to carefully consider the above prior to submitting your application as Surgor follows a stringent selection process. Should the above not be acceptable to you once you've been admitted into the programme, it may result in another deserving learner's application not being considered and would negatively impact the selection process.
